

Dr. Christos Papadimitriou is Medical Oncologist and Professor of "Therapeutics-Oncology" at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, School of Medicine. Today he is head of the Oncology Unit of the Second Department of Surgery at "Aretaieion" Hospital. He graduated in Athens (1982) from the School of Medicine with the highest degree. From 1987-1992 he specialized in Internal Medicine in the Department of Pathologic Physiology (Athens) and he received his PhD degree in excellence in 1989. From 1993 to 1995 he was trained in Hematology, Oncology and Bone Marrow Transplantation in the Hematology/Oncology Department of the University Hospital Charité Berlin-Campus Benjamin Franklin, as a fellow of ESMO. From 1995-2014 he worked in the Department of Clinical Therapeutics of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens in "Alexandra" Hospital, where he substantially contributed to the development of the Oncology and BMT Unit. He authored or co-authored 216 articles in peer-reviewed medical journals (including the most significant of them) and 40 chapters in textbooks, while he has given over 170 lectures as invited speaker. For his scientific work he has been honored with numerous awards. His research and clinical interests focus on breast cancer, gynecological cancer, gastrointestinal cancer and bone marrow transplantation.
