

Dr. Aias-Theodoros Papastavrou is Consultant Ear, Nose & Throat Surgeon.

He graduated from the National Kapodistrian University of Athens in 1978 and received his PhD degree in 1988 from the same University. His subspecialty training includes fellowship in neurotology and ear surgery at the University of Minnesota, fellowship in endoscopic nasal surgery and LASER surgery at the University of Erlangen –Germany.
