

### Curriculum vitae

Prof. Dr. med. Dipl.-Phys. Peter Wust was born in 1953 and studied Physics (specific topic Nuclear Physics) 1973-78 with Diploma in 1978 (Dipl.-Phys.). Then he studied Medicine and achieved a Certificate for Medical Physics in 1982, the Approbation (approval as Medical Doctor) in 1983 and the doctoral degree in 1984 (Dr.med.). He achieved the Certificate as Radiologist in 1990 and as Radiation Oncologist 1993. The postdoctoral qualification (Habilitation) was achieved 1993. From 1994-2003 he coordinated a special interdisciplinary research project upon hyperthermia (Sonderforschungsbereich 273) and became Professor for Radiation Oncology in 2000.

Prof. Wust worked in the University Clinic Charité since 1984, since 1994 as Consultant for Radiation Oncology (Senior Physician). Since 2006 he is Head of the Outpatient Department of Radiotherapy at the Charité (Ambulantes Gesundheitszentrum, Campus Virchow Klinikum) and is responsible for the radiooncological treatment of ambulatory patients, in special cases in combination with hyperthermia.

In 2017 Prof. Wust has 312 items in the Web of Science with > 10.000 citations and h-index 46. In PubMed 250 contributions on the field of Radiation Oncology, Radiology, Medical Physics and Hyperthermia are listed. He wrote several Chapters in Teaching Books and recently a Monography "Thermotherapy in Oncology" in 2016, UNI-MED Verlag Bremen.
