

CURRICULUM VITAE Jacoba van der Zee, M.D., Ph.D., Erasmus MC Cancer Institute, Dept. of Radiation Oncology, Hyperthermia Unit, Rotterdam, the Netherlands.

Studied medicine at the University of Amsterdam (B.Sc. 1974) and the State University of Leiden (M.D. 1978) and achieved her Ph.D. at the Erasmus University in Rotterdam (1987). Is since 1978 involved in the clinical research of hyperthermia at the Erasmus MC Cancer Institute. Was Board member of the European Society for Hyperthermic Oncology (ESHO) from 1991 to 1994 and from 2000 to 2003, and president of ESHO from 1996 to 1999. Was editorial board member of the International Journal of Hyperthermia. Is winner of several awards among which the Lund Science Award (1994), the ESHO-BSD Award (1999), and the Eugene Robinson Award. Was appointed Knight in the Order of Orange-Nassau by the Queen of the Netherlands in 2010 for her contributions in the field of hyperthermia. Is (co)author of more than 100 peer-reviewed publications on whole body hyperthermia, local hyperthermia, interstitial hyperthermia, hyperthermic perfusion, quality assurance guidelines, and tumour pH, and of several reviews.
